Coaches Information:

Ripon – Julie Johnson is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 237-180 in her 17+ seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Carroll – Kris Jacobsen is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Carroll College history, with a career 147-92 record in 10 years with the Pioneers. Jacobsen has led Carroll to consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances, including their first and only MWC Championship in the 2005-06 season. That season, the Pioneers advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament with a 64-57 first-round upset win over 14th ranked Calvin (MI) College, earning the program's first ever NCAA Tournament win. Jacobsen was named Midwest Conference and Central Region Coach of the Year following the 05-06 season.

Scouting The Opponent: Carroll has already clinched a spot in the MWC Tournament and is still battling for the number two seed. They are looking to get back on track after Saturday's loss at St. Norbert snapped their nine-game winning streak. The Pioneers are scoring 67 points per game on offense, while giving up an average of 58.1 on defense, both of which rank third in the Midwest Conference. They lead the MWC in defending the 3-point shot, allowing opponents to shoot just 21.6 percent from beyond the arc. Carroll has won the last four meetings between these two teams, and five of the last six, including a MWC Tournament semi-final game in 2006.

Player To Watch: Crystal Hoewisch is the reigning Midwest Conference Player of the Year, while also being named First-Team All-Conference in each of her first three seasons with the Pioneers. She is on her way to her fourth consecutive MWC First-Team selection this year, as she leads the Pioneers with 19.3 points per game, which is second in the MWC. Hoewisch also ranks 11th in rebounding (6.5 rpg), sixth in assists (3.2), and third in field goal percentage (.525). The senior from Hortonville, Wis. is also fourth in the conference in steals, averaging 2.3 steals per game.

LOOKING AHEAD: Ripon will wrap up the 2007-08 season this Saturday, when they'll travel to Beloit College. The Buccaneers are 9-6 in conference play and need a win against the Red Hawks to clinch the fourth and final spot in the Midwest Conference Tournament. Beloit won the earlier meeting this season against the Red Hawks, winning 61-43 in Ripon.

ROUTE 66: The Red Hawks been on a scoring spree as of late, putting up at least 66 points in each of their last three games, all RC wins. The last four times Ripon has reached 66 points, they have won the game. They are 4-1 when reaching that mark this year, with the only exception being a 78-67 loss at Illinois College early in the season.

STEALING RECORDS: Ripon's Carissa Zuercher is on the verge of etching her name in the Ripon College single season record book. The sophomore has recorded 47 steals this season, which is three away from moving into 10th place for a single season. Fellow Red Hawk Jessica DeHamer also has a shot at cracking the top ten, as she is just five steals away, with 45 on the year.

CHARITABLE DIFFERENCES: Ripon and Carroll enter tonight's game with opposite results from the free throw line. The Pioneers currently lead the Midwest Conference, shooting 76 percent from the line, while Ripon ranks dead last, making 62 percent of their shots from the charity stripe.

DYNAMIC DUO: Carroll's Crystal Hoewisch and Kim Wickert have been the heart and soul of the Pioneers this season. They are the only pair of teammates in the MWC to rank in the top 11 in points, rebounds, and field goal percentage. Hoewisch is averaging 19.3 points and 6.5 rebounds, while shooting 53 percent from the field. Wickert meanwhile is averaging 12.9 points and 7.2 rebounds, while shooting 48 percent.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS: Carroll's defense has been a big strength of their team this season. The Pioneers have only allowed opponents to score 64 points in four games, each time resulting in a Carroll loss.
