Coaches Information:

Ripon - Julie Johnson is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 232-170 in her 17+ seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Knox - Wendy Rogers is in her third season as head coach of the Knox women's basketball program. Rogers, a native of Newton, Massachusetts, arrived at Knox after three years at Salem State College, where she was an assistant coach for the women's basketball team and assistant director of athletics. During her time at Salem State, the basketball program earned three NCAA Division III tournament berths. While earning her bachelor's degree from Eastern Connecticut State University, Rogers' teams made appearances at the NCAA Division III Women's Basketball Final Four in 1991 and 1992. During her senior year at ECSU, Rogers was named Honorable Mention All-America. In 2004, she was inducted into the Eastern Connecticut State University Athletic Hall of Fame.

Scouting The Opponent: Knox has struggled to score this season, as their 51-point performance against Wartburg is their highest scoring game this season. Knox is scoring 48.3 points per game, while also giving up an average of 72.7 points, which means the Prairie Fire have lost their three games thus far by an average of 24.3 points. They have been outscored 111-60 in the second half of games this year. One problem they've had is getting the ball through the hoop, as they've shot just 32 percent from the field. Their opponents on the other hand have made 42 percent of their field goals. Knox has been out rebounded by 14 boards per contest, as they are giving up 49 rebounds to opponents. One thing Knox has going for them is their ability to protect the basket down low. The Prairie Fire have recorded 17 blocked shots through three games.

Player To Watch: **Madi Hanna** is the only player on Knox's team that is averaging double-figures in points, scoring 12.0 points per game. The freshman is also averaging 5.3 rebounds per contest and has blocked 11 shots (3.7 bpg) thus far. Hanna is coming off her first career start, in which she recorded 12 points and four rebounds in 21 minutes of action. She also managed to block five shots in that loss against Rockford College, four of which came in the first half.

Looking Ahead: The Red Hawks will remain on the road for Saturday's game at Illinois College. The Lady Blues entered the weekend with a 2-2 record, with wins against Mount St. Joseph's and Hannibal-LaGrange. Ripon split the season series with IC last season, with the home team winning each game. The Red Hawks won by nine at Ripon, but lost by 22 in Jacksonville, Ill. later in the season.

Last Meeting vs. Knox: Ripon won their last meeting with Knox College, defeating the Prairie Fire 66-60 in Galesburg, Ill., despite trailing by 14 points at halftime. After shooting 54 percent in the first half, Knox made just 27 percent of their shots in the second period. The Red Hawks were led by JoEllen Buerger's 21 points and 10 rebounds. Jessica DeHamer added 16 points and nine boards. Leading the way for Knox was Andie Allison, who finished with 15 points and eight rebounds, while also blocking four shots.

Getting It Done Down Low: The Red Hawks have been led by a pair of forwards this season. Sophomore Jessica DeHamer and junior Jeni Yaeger are the only two Red Hawks that are averaging double figures scoring this season, as they have combined to score 52 percent of the team's points. DeHamer leads the team with 13.4 points per game, while Yaeger is second, averaging 12.8 points. That duo also leads the team in rebounding, as DeHamer has pulled down 7.2 rebounds per game, which is slightly better than Yaeger's 7.0 rebounds per contest.

Hold Them To 50: One sure way of Ripon winning games this year has been keeping opponents under the 50-point mark. The Red Hawks have lost all three games in which they've allowed opponents to score over 50 points, while also winning both games in which they have held opponents under the 50-point mark.
