Coaches Information:

Ripon - Julie Johnson is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 230-167 in her 17 seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Northland - Dan Roiger is beginning his fourth season as coach of the women's program. In his first three years, he has led the Jill's to the conference playoffs twice, including a 10-4 finish last season that saw the Lumberjills finish in second place, earning him the UMAC Coach of the Year award. In just the first two recruiting classes, Coach Roiger has upgraded the Jill's roster in depth, size, and athleticism. He has recruited six players over six feet and five players who have been recognized as All-State. Prior to Northland, Roiger was the head coach at Carleton College for two years. In those two seasons, Carleton finished 49-7, won the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference both years, and advanced to the second round of the NCAA D-III National Tournament each season.

Scouting The Opponent: Northland College is coming off a season that saw them finish 14-12 overall and 10-4 in the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference, placing them in a three-way tie for second place in the conference standings. Northland had a rough start to the 2006-07 season, losing seven of their first nine games, but they turned things around at mid-season, with a pair of four-game win streaks. The Lumberjills proved that they could win the close game last season, winning five games that were decided by five points or less, including two in overtime. They return four of their five starters from last season and their only new starter, sophomore point guard Lindsey Hamm, played in all 26 games last season, averaging 26.2 minutes per game off the bench. All five starters for Northland averaged at least five points and two rebounds per game last season. The Lumberjills have just one senior on this season's team, in guard Evelyn Hoosier.

Player To Watch: **Chelsey Lundgren** is Northland's top returning scorer from a year ago, coming off a season where she averaged 13.1 points per game. Lundgren is also the team's top returning rebounder, averaging 6.9 rebounds per game in the 2006-07 season. She also led Northland in both field goal percentage (.495) and steals (50), while ranking third on the team in blocks (13). Only a sophomore, Lundgren already has career highs of 26 points and 14 rebounds. She led the team in minutes played as a freshman, averaging 29.6 minutes per game.

Looking Ahead: Ripon will continue play in the Lakeland College Tip-off Tournament on Saturday, Nov. 17. They will face either Augustana (IL) or Lakeland depending on how they fare against Northland. They will play at either 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. The Red Hawks will then get ready for their home opener on Tuesday, Nov. 20 against UW-Oshkosh at 7:00 p.m. That will be their only non-conference home game this season, as they won't return home until their second conference game of the year against St. Norbert on Dec. 5 at 5:30 p.m.

Key Losses: The Red Hawks will have to find a few new players to step up this year, after losing seven players from last season's squad. Those seven players produced 70 percent of the team's scoring and 55 percent of the team's rebounding. Five of last year's top six scorers and two of last year's top three rebounders are not with the team this season.

Youth Movement: The Red Hawks are once again one of the youngest teams in the Midwest Conference, as they'll take the court for the 2007-08 season with just two seniors and one junior on the roster. They are overflowing with freshmen and sophomores, as Ripon has eight second-year players and five players that will be making their collegiate basketball debut Friday night.

Hamering The Competition: Forward Jessica DeHamer will be expected to take another step in her development as an all-around player this season. The sophomore is the team's leading returning scorer, rebounder, and assist producer, as she averaged 7.7 points and 4.8 rebounds, and 1.4 assists per game last year. DeHamer also ranked third on the team in field goal percentage, making 47 percent of her shots from the field.
