Coaches Information:

Ripon – Julie Johnson is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 232-169 in her 17+ seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Wheaton – Beth Baker is in her 22nd season as head women's basketball coach at Wheaton College. Baker has led the Thunder to six CCIW Championships and seven NCAA Tournament appearances and has had four players receive All-American status. Baker has won 72.0 percent of her games (393-153). Baker guided the 2006-07 edition of the Thunder to a third-straight CCIW Championship and the program's third NCAA Tournament appearance in a four-year span. Prior to coming to Wheaton, Baker coached basketball at Avondale and Redan High Schools in Georgia, leading Avondale to two regional championships and a two-year record of 44-7. Baker played basketball at Wheaton for four years, graduating with a bachelor's degree in health and physical education in 1977.

Scouting The Opponent: Wheaton is off to a great start to the 2007-08 season, winning three of their first four games. Two of their three victories have come by at least 10 points. One reason for the Thunder's early season success is their long-range shooting, as they have made 37 percent (17-46) of their three-point shots. They have four players that are shooting at least 50 percent from behind the arc this season. Wheaton has done work on the offensive boards thus far, out rebounding opponents 57-42 on the offensive glass. Wheaton's only loss this year came against UW-Stevens Point, as the Pointers remained undefeated by defeating the Thunder 65-54 on November 24th.

Player To Watch: Kathleen Fidelia is off to a hot start to the season, as she is leading the Thunder in four different statistical categories, while ranking second in another. Fidelia is averaging a team-best 17.0 points, 7.5 assists, 4.8 steals, and 84.2 percent shooting from the free throw line. She also ranks second on the team in rebounding with 6.0 boards per game. The junior guard from Arden, North Carolina has started all four games this season and is averaging a team-best 35.8 minutes per game. Fidelia has protected the ball very well early in the year, as her assist-to-turn-over ratio is nearly two to one.

Looking Ahead: The Red Hawks will open their conference season this weekend with games on consecutive days against Knox College and Illinois College. They will square off with the Prairie Fire on Friday at 5:00 p.m. in Galesburg, Ill. The Red Hawks won both games against Knox last season, while splitting their season series with Illinois College.

Last Meeting vs. Wheaton: The Thunder defeated the Red Hawks 55-40 in last year's meeting between these two schools. The game was tied with 10 and a half minutes remaining, before Wheaton went on a 20-5 run to end the game and secure a victory. Ripon shot just 23 percent in the second half, while Wheaton made 54 percent of their shots in the final period. Sara Gustafson led the Red Hawks with 14 points and five rebounds, while Jill Trenz paced the Thunder with 16 points and 10 boards.

Stepping Up: Senior guard Tiffany Goebel started the first game of her Red Hawk career Saturday against Concordia (WI) and didn't disappoint. Goebel scored a career-high 16 points, beating her previous career high of four. She also recorded a team-high six rebounds and two steals. The Owen, Wis. native is averaging 6.5 points per game, which ranks third on the team. That is 5.5 points above her career scoring average. Goebel ranks first on the team in field goal percentage (50%), while also ranking second in free throw percentage (64.3%). She is also first in three-point shooting, making her only attempt from downtown.

The Iron Unkind: Ripon has continued to struggle from behind the arc this season. They are shooting 10 percent from three-point range, making four of their 40 attempts. The Red Hawks have missed 13 consecutive three-pointers, dating back to the first half against UW-Oshkosh on November 20th. No one on the team has made more than one three-point shot.
