Coaches Information:

Ripon – Julie Johnson is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 237-181 in her 17+ seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Beloit – Don Adams is in his first year as head coach of the Buccaneers. Prior to Beloit, Adams spent the two seasons as the assistant women's basketball coach at the University of Maine at Orono and helped guide the Black Bears to a pair of America East Conference regular-season championships. Maine compiled a 45-17 record during those two years, captured the 2003-04 conference tournament title, and appeared in the 2004 NCAA Tournament and 2005 National Invitational Tournament. During the 2002-03 season, he was an assistant coach at the University of Wisconsin. He also has served as an assistant women's basketball coach at Clarke College (IA) and as an assistant boys basketball coach at Cassville High School for three seasons.

Scouting The Opponent: Beloit has already clinched a spot in the Midwest Conference Tournament. They will be the number four seed and will play tournament host St. Norbert College in the semi-finals. The Buccaneers had lost four consecutive games, before winning last Saturday against Lawrence. Beloit has been hitting the boards hard all season, as they rank second in the Midwest Conference with 40.1 rebounds per game. They have also protected the ball well this season, leading the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio. Beloit defeated Ripon in their earlier meeting this season, winning 61-43 in Ripon.

Player To Watch: **Christine Brown** has been one of the Midwest Conference's best all-around players this season. The junior is in the top three on her team in virtually every major statistical category. Brown is second on the team in scoring, averaging 12.7 points per game, while also leading the team in rebounding with 9.9 rebounds per contest. Brown is third on her team in assists, dishing out 2.7 assists per game. She has started all 22 games for the Buccaneers, averaging 33.8 minutes per game.

SENIOR SWAN SONG: Saturday's game will be the final game in two Ripon player's careers. Senior guards Tiffany Goebel and Christina Schneider will take the court one final time, as they'll try to go out with a bang. Goebel is averaging career highs in every category this season and is averaging more than two points and two rebounds above her career average. Schneider has been an important part of Ripon's bench this season and has doubled her career scoring average this season.

STEALING RECORDS: With three steals against Carroll College on Wednesday, Ripon's Carissa Zuercher moved into a tie for tenth place for most steals in a single season in Ripon history. If she can manage four steals against the Buccaneers, Zuercher could move into seventh place in that category. Fellow Red Hawk Jessica DeHamer also has a shot at cracking the top ten for most steals in a single season. She is just five steals away from tenth place.

FANTASTIC FRESHMAN: Emily Meyer has come on strong during the second half of the season, in this, her first year of playing college basketball. Meyer has scored in double figures in eight consecutive games, which is the longest such streak since Janine Emmer scored in double figures 10 straight times during the 2004-05 season. Meyer has been the Red Hawk's leading scorer in each of those games.

MCCOOLER THAN THE OTHER SIDE OF THE PILLOW: In Beloit's last seven games, the one running theme is that Katie McCool must score if Beloit's going to win. The Buccaneers are 3-4 in those seven games and McCool has been the leading scorer in all three of their wins in that stretch. In those three wins, McCool has averaged 21 points per game, while averaging 6.3 points per game in the four losses in that stretch.

HIGH AVERAGES: Beloit is the only team in the Midwest Conference to have three players in the top ten in scoring. McCool is fifth in the MWC, averaging 13.4 points per game, while Christine Brown and Angie Meehan rank ninth and tenth, respectively. Brown is averaging 12.7 points per game, while Meehan has scored 12.4 points per contest.
