## Coaches Information:

**Ripon – Julie Johnson** is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 234-180 in her 17+ seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

**Illinois College – Brenna Kelly** has racked up 243 wins in her first 19+ seasons with the Lady Blues. The Kahoka, Mo. native and former Culver-Stockton College standout has compiled impressive credentials since taking over the reins of the Illinois College women's basketball program in 1987. Now in her 20th season, Kelly has steered the Lady Blues to a prominent position in the Midwest Conference. Her teams own an overall record of 243-199, and qualified for the league's post-season championship tournament from 1991 through 1997, and again in 1999. That run produced a league title in 1993 and runner-up finishes in 1997, 1998, and 1999. Her induction into the Illinois College Sports Hall of Fame in 1996 underscored her status as one of IC's all-time coaching leaders.

**Scouting The Opponent:** Illinois College is coming off a blow-out win against Knox College on Tuesday, which snapped a three-game losing streak for the Lady Blues. They have won just two of their last seven games. IC's offense has been somewhat up-tempo this year, as they've averaged 70.3 points per game, while giving up 68.3 points to their opponents. The Lady Blues have also outrebounded opponents by nearly six boards per game. They've been a different team on the road however, going 2-5 away from Jacksonville, Ill. They are 6-3 at home.

**Player To Watch:** Brittany Parsons is the leader of the Illinois College offense, starting all 18 games this season as the team's point guard. She currently ranks second in the Midwest Conference in assists, averaging 3.8 per game. The junior from Frankfort, Ind. is also second on the team in 3-point shooting, making 37 percent of her shots from long-range. In addition to that, Parsons is averaging 7.6 points and 1.7 rebounds per game this season.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** The Red Hawks will be in action once again on Saturday, as they'll face Knox College, who enter the weekend tied for last place with Ripon in the Midwest Conference standings. Each team has also experienced their roughest stretch of their schedule as of late. Entering the weekend doubleheader, Ripon had lost seven games in a row, which is the team's longest losing streak since dropping 13 in a row during the 1989-90 season. Knox has also been in their biggest slump of the year, losing six straight entering their game on Friday. Those losing streaks are the longest of the season for both teams. Earlier this season, Knox defeated Ripon 61-48 in Galesburg, Ill., snapping the Prairie Fire's 28-game conference losing streak.

**MEYER MAKES AN IMPACT:** Ripon freshman Emily Meyer continues to come into her own in the second half of the season. Meyer has recorded three double-doubles in the past four games for the Red Hawks and has led the team in scoring in all four of those contests. In the past four games, Meyer is averaging 18.3 points and 9.8 rebounds, while also shooting 47 percent (27-59) from the field in those games.

**SCORING DIFFERENCES:** Ripon and Illinois College couldn't be more different on the offensive side of the ball. The Red Hawks rank last in scoring in the Midwest Conference, averaging 51.2 points per game, while the Lady Blues rank second, scoring 70.3 points per contest. Ripon is also last in the MWC in field goal percentage, shooting 35 percent from the floor. Illinois College meanwhile is shooting 42 percent, which ranks third in the MWC.

**DON'T SLEEP ON NAPIER:** Illinois College's Laren Napier has played as well as anyone on the team as of late. The sophomore forward has recorded a double-double in each of the last two games. She is averaging 18.5 points and 10.5 rebounds in those two games.

**LINEUP CHANGES:** After the first five games of the season, in which Illinois College went 2-3, the Lady Blues decided to switch up their lineup, beginning with their game against Ripon on December 1st. After placing sophomore Laren Napier and freshman Rachel Maccon into the lineup, Illinois College won five of their next six games. They are 7-6 since making that linueup change.
