Coaches Information:

Ripon - Julie Johnson is the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in Ripon history, compiling an overall record of 232-173 in her 17+ seasons as head coach. Under Johnson's leadership, Ripon has qualified for the conference tournament nine of the past 13 years, including three trips to the NCAA tournament (1996, 2004, 2005). Johnson has been named MWC coach of the year three times (1995, 2004, 2005), while also being named NCAA women's basketball Central Region Coach of the Year once. Johnson earned her bachelor's degree from Dakota State University in 1988, where she was a four-year starter and named to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Centenary - Lorie Khalil is in her third season as the Head Coach of the Lady Cyclones Basketball program. Last year, she led Centenary to a 12-13 overall record and a qualifying spot in the Sky-line Conference Tournament. This winter she looks to make the Lady Cyclones presence known in their first season in the Pennsylvania Athletic Conference (PAC). Khalil is a 2003 graduate of Moravian College, where she was a two-year member of the women's basketball team. Prior to transferring to Moravian, Khalil originally attended Delaware Valley College where she also played two seasons for their women's program. While at DVC, she was a participant on their 2000-2001 ECAC Mid-Atlantic Region Championship team.

Scouting The Opponent: Centenary is off to a great start to the 2007-08 season, winning three of their first four games, while splitting a pair of Pennsylvania Athletic Conference contests. In their four wins, Centenary has defeated opponents by an average of 26 points. The Cyclone defense has been outstanding, holding opponents to just 29 percent shooting thus far, including 19 percent from behind the 3-point line. On offense, Centenary is shooting 35 percent from 3-point range. The Cyclones have outrebounded opponents this season by an average of seven boards per game. They currently lead opponents in every offensive and defensive category. The Cyclones have eight players that are averaging at least 17 minutes per game this season.

Player To Watch: **Stephanie Roberts** has had a tremendous start to her season for the Cyclones, leading the team in both scoring and rebounding, while ranking second on the squad in assists. Roberts is averaging 17.3 points, 11.8 rebounds, and 3.3 assists per game. The Bakersfield, Calif. native has started all four games this season and is averaging 28.5 minutes per contest, which is third on the team. Roberts has shot 47 percent (25-53) from the field this year, while also making 75 percent (18-24) of her foul shots.

Looking Ahead: The Red Hawks will be in Texas until December 30th, when they'll return home to Wisconsin. After Friday's game, Ripon will take on either Ohio Wesleyan or Adrian (MI) in day two action of the South Padre Island Invitational. The time will differ, depending on their opponent. Ripon will play Saturday's game at either 2:00 or 4:00 p.m. After their trip, the Red Hawks will resume Midwest Conference play on January 12th at Lawrence University.

Opponents On Fire: Ripon has lost four games in a row, which is largely due to their opponents shooting the lights out. In those four contests, Red Hawk opponents have shot 47 percent (94-199) from the field. Four of the five highest field goal percentages against the Red Hawks have come in the previous four contests.

Meister Looks For Her Shot: Sophomore point guard Ashley Meister has taken scoring matters into her own hands the past couple of games. Meister is averaging nine points per contest in Ripon's last two games. That is five points above her season average. Those nine points she's scored in each of the past two ball games is a career high for the Suamico, Wis. native.

Wide Open Scores: Win or lose this season, the Red Hawks have yet to be in a game that goes down to the wire. Out of their six games, just one of them has been decided by less than ten points, which came in a nine-point victory at Concordia (WI). They have lost their six games by at least 11 points, while winning their only other game by 11 points.

Say Yes To Yaeger: Junior forward Jeni Yaeger has played well in Ripon's two victories this season. The Clintonville, Wis. native is averaging 14.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game in the Red Hawk's pair of wins. That is 4.1 points and 1.1 rebounds above her season averages this year.
